

ROLE 5: ASSIST ELECTED OFFICIALS OR CITIZENS

Practice 5a. External advocacy: Advocate to, or assist, external stakeholders, concerning the development, implementation, or improvement of government performance management systems.

Portland, Oregon, City Auditor: (www.portlandonline.com/auditor): The City Auditor's December 2002 report *Managing for Results: A Proposal for the City of Portland* is addressed to the Mayor and City Council, and includes a recommendation for the City Council to adopt a managing for results ordinance, conduct citywide strategic planning, and adopt a City mission and goals. (This entity-wide managing for results proposal is mainly reported under practice 4a, as City Council members have an executive management role in the Portland city government, as well as a legislative policy role.) In February 2003, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 36123 directing the Office of Management and Finance to prepare an implementation plan for a City managing for results process which was completed in June, 2003. The City Auditor's Office continues to provide technical assistance and advice (see 4b).
